Those Amzing Grop Groles: Where Do They Come From?

Researchers Marilyn Penrod and Maria Tadd will give us a close look at what many call "sacred works of art"

Who are the circle makers? Or what is the creative force behind the circles? Why did they originate in Britain? Or did they? Is this a recent thing or did they start in ancient times? What are they trying to communicate?

Those are just some of the questions that Crop Circle Researchers Marilyn Penrod and Maria Tadd will try to answer Sept. 7 when they visit Raleigh to meet with us.

"We will present the latest information/theories about this mysterious phenomenon and show photos of formations from this and previous years," Maria said. "Taking a closer look at these exquisite temporary sacred works of art ,we will examine their precision, their relationships to mathematical principles such as the golden mean, fractals, and sacred geometry. We will show compelling evidence that supports their authenticity."

The crop circle phenomenon first came to people's attention in the mid 70s, but was not until 1990 that the first straight line appeared in Britain. That formation, the first of the so-called pictograms, signaled an evolutionary transformation in the phenomenon, which had leapt from simple circles to complex forms. The years since have been truly years of expansion and change in the circles, the second half of the 90s demonstrating a consistency of beauty and inventiveness.

Though Britain remain the world center of the phenomenon, many remarkable formations have been discovered elsewhere, including this country.



Peculiarities of Grop Grcles

There are a number of observations that have been made by researchers over the years of particular characteristics that Crop Circle formations exhibit. Here's a look at some of them.

In what kind of crops do they occur?


Crop circles have been reported in more barley and wheat. But, they also apper in corn, oats, oilseed rape (canola), gracicefields, trees, sand, and even snow.

Where do they appear? - They have appeared on every continent and been reported in over 70 countries worldwide. A large number have appeared in the former Czech Republic and the latest report is that over 2,000 have appeared in India alone.

Change to the grain - not only does the physical appearance of seem to change (it looks dehydrated), but there is change at the molecular level. Research has been conducted with samples from many seasons by the Burks-Levengood-Talbot (BLT) research team in Massachusetts. In addition, farmers have reported greater yield in the years following the appearance of formations in their fields. Tim Carson who farms *East Field* (where the "DNA" formation appeared in 1996) reported to researchers that his yield was up 30-40%.

Swirl in multiple directions - many formations have complex woven patterns of the swirled crops. Not only do the plants in the formation swirl clock-

wise or counterclockwise, but some-



Woven stalks - Other times the stalks are actually woven like a piece of loose cloth on the floor of the formation. This has been observed by various researchers in the UK.

Selective swirling - Even though the edges are clearly defined, sometimes stalks from the outside edge are pulled into the formation. This doesn't

seem to be too unusual, but actually certain stalks from the middle of a grouping of plants gets pulled in. The ones closest to the formation do not. And this occurs around the entire edge of the crop circle. Very meticulous!



Equipment malfunctions - Many researchers have experienced electronic equipment failure in crop circles and magnets going haywire. This includes watches and mobile phones. No explanations for this occurrence yet.

Emit sound at 5KHz frequency - Researchers have measured a distinct emission of energy at 5KHz emanating from fresh (few days after formed) crop circles. This corresponds to reports of eye-witnesses who often claim to hear a "trilling" sound coming from the direction of the formations-in-the-make.

Formations "transform" into new patterns - There have been instances where certain formations take on an entirely different appearance as they continue to grow in the field. For example, one formation got a wavy look within the center of the circle that wasn't there originally.

Anomalous measurements - By doing a fluxgate magnetometer survey of several formations, Colin Andrews determined that the very center of these circles measured 40-50 nano Teslas. This is 10 times the radiation level of a normal field.

Aligned with natural features of the land - This isn't apparent from the ground, but aerial photographs have shown that often formations are imprinted on the earth in alignment with train lines or even darkened sections on the earth.

Sacred geometry - Researchers have discovered layers within layers of information contained in the crop circles themselves. There are sacred ratios, such as phi, that governs the growth process of all organic life.

Dear Spirit Coach,

Someone said that I could do automatic writing, but I don't have a clue how to begin. Can you help?

Dear Mildred,

To tap into the level where you can "encourage" automatic writing to occur, try the following approach.

Your first task is to quiet the left brain thinking process by getting into a meditative, or alpha state. A simple approach to facilitate reaching alpha was discussed by Herbert Benson, M.D. in his 1975 groundbreaking mind/body healing book, *Relaxation Response*, that dealt with the physiological benefits of meditation.

Get into a comfortable position with a pad and pen close at hand. Be sure that you will not be startled or disturbed. With Dr. Benson's approach, you use the word "One" as your mantra. Close your eyes and let the word "One" move through your mind as loudly, or as softly, as slowly or quickly as it will. Don't judge it, just let it repeat—"One, One, One". When (left brain) thoughts intrude, just bring your mind back to the word "One." Eventually you will get to a quiet place (alpha state) and it is from here that you can do the automatic writing. The thoughts that come now are of a different quality than the left brain thoughts.

If you have a specific topic you want to explore, write it at the top of the page to use as a "seed thought". After you have reached the alpha state, partially open your eyes so you can see the sentence and see the lines, re-read the sentence and write what comes to mind. Don't judge anything, including the content or how automatic it may or may not feel. Write what comes, and when the flow stops, re-read the seed sentence again and write again.

This process is about your being willing to be there and accept whatever comes (or does not come) through. Think of this as a sacred moment to receive a message from your Higher Self, and honor the commitment as you would an appointment to meet with a high spiritual being or God, for indeed, that is what it is.

CHOOSING A REIKI MASTER

The choice of a Reiki Master is very important. This is the person who will crack open the door to a new world of awakening experiences. Interviews with the many people in this area who teach Reiki will be well worth the time.

Good things to know include what type of Reiki is taught (Traditional Usui, Tibetan, Karuna, etc.). How long has the person been doing Reiki and what is their lineage? What is covered in class and how many hours are involved? How many attunements are given and how much time is allowed between them? Will you receive a certificate and a study manual and how complete is it? Is the study manual updated and revised with new, well-researched material?

How accessible is the Master? Does s/he return calls promptly? Does s/he take time to talk to you when you call? How will you be supported in your learning experience after class is completed? Are you provided opportunities to share Reiki with others in groups or by doing exchanges with the Master?

What kind of vibes do you get from the Master? How does the Master live life (based on faith or fear, centered around self or service to others)? Is s/he respectful of Masters of other affiliations? Listen to your own inner guidance, follow your heart and you will make the correct choice.

Remember, being a Master means having mastery over

oneself.
